## INCREASE IN THE DOLLAR LIMITS OF PROCUREMENTS ELIGIBLE TO USE THE SMALL WORKS ROSTER METHOD OF SOLICITATION

**WHEREAS**, the Housing Authority, in the course of its daily business, contracts for and acquires goods and services, and;

**WHEREAS**, the use of a Small Works Roster is one method allowed by RCW 39.04 to solicit business participation in acquiring goods and services, and;

**WHEREAS**, the dollar limits to allow the use of a Small Works Roster as a solicitation method can be up to \$100,000 for Federally funded contracts, and;

**WHEREAS**, the King County Housing Authority allows the use of a Small Works Roster in the current Procurement Policy, approved with Resolution No. 3067 on April 13th, 2000, and;

**WHEREAS**, the current Procurement Policy limits the use of a Small Works Roster to \$40,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF KING:

That in Section II-E of the Procurement Policy, Small Works Roster, the solicitation limit is to be raised to \$100,000.
