AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION TO THE KING COUNTY COMMUNITY BLOCK GRANT CONSORTIUM FUNDING IN SUPPORT OF AVONDALE MANOR COMMUNITY ROOM CAPITAL PROJECT UPGRADES

WHEREAS, the King County Housing Authority is working on a capital project to renovate the community room at Avondale Manor, a family public housing community located in the City of Redmond; and

WHEREAS, funding is being sought to ensure adequate resources for project implementation and completion.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF KING:


The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Executive Director to submit a Community Development Block Grant application to the King County Community Block Grant Consortium in the amount of \$174,792 to assist with the capital construction project at Avondale Manor.

The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Executive Director to modify these applications or to submit additional applications for CDBG grants in this funding round as circumstances require.
