

**THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF KING
RESOLUTION NO. 5235**

**AUTHORIZING CHANGES TO THE PUBLIC HOUSING ADMISSIONS AND
CONTINUED OCCUPANCY POLICY (ACOP) RELATING TO THE
TRANSFER POLICY**

WHEREAS, the Public Housing Program is administered within previously adopted program guidelines known as the Public Housing Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy (herein called the “ACOP”); and,

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority currently has already adopted a transfer policy that affords residents the ability to transfer between different subsidized programs; and,

WHEREAS, this policy has been in effect since December 1, 2007; and,

WHEREAS, KCHA management has analyzed the results of the first 18 months of the policy being implemented; and,

WHEREAS, KCHA management has concluded that several changes should be made to the policy in order to increase its effectiveness and allow for more resident transfer opportunities; and,

WHEREAS, Board approval of revised operational policies and procedures is required before KCHA can implement such changes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF KING:

Section 1: Hereby adopts the revisions to the Public Housing Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy as attached;

Section 2: Authorizes the Housing Authority to take the necessary steps to implement these revisions effective September 1, 2009.
