

**THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF KING  
RESOLUTION NO. 5236**

**AUTHORIZING CHANGES TO THE PUBLIC HOUSING ADMISSIONS AND  
CONTINUED OCCUPANCY POLICY (ACOP) RELATING TO  
MAINTENANCE CHARGES**

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**WHEREAS**, the Public Housing Program is administered within previously adopted program guidelines known as the Public Housing Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy (herein called the “ACOP”); and,

**WHEREAS**, the Housing Authority has historically charged residents for resident-caused damages and lease violations; and,

**WHEREAS**, these charges have not been updated since 1995; and,

**WHEREAS**, the proposed policy changes would allow KCHA to more accurately charge for resident-caused damages; and,

**WHEREAS**, public comment notices were posted at affected KCHA properties and public comments that were received were reviewed by KCHA management; and,

**WHEREAS**, Board approval of revised operational policies and procedures is required before KCHA can implement such changes.



**Section 1:** Hereby adopts the revisions to the Public Housing Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy as attached; and

**Section 2:** Authorizes the Housing Authority to take the necessary steps to implement these revisions effective September 1, 2009.
