AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN KCHA AND A REGIONAL COALITION FOR HOUSING (ARCH)

WHEREAS, as part of its HOPE VI application to HUD, KCHA pledged to make available 80 project-based subsidized units as part of the redevelopment effort; and

WHEREAS, to support deconcentration of affordable housing, KCHA has determined that these project-based vouchers shall be made available in the north and east parts of King County; and

WHEREAS, KCHA successfully partnered with ARCH to administer a previous allocation of 120 project-based vouchers through the ARCH application process; and

WHEREAS, KCHA's Moving to Work agreement with HUD allows the Authority to modify HUD procedures and requirements regarding the competitive award of project-based vouchers;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF KING:

- 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby approves the execution of a Memorandum of Agreement between KCHA and ARCH; and
- 2. Approves future ministerial changes to the MOA with ARCH without the Board of Commissioners' approval.
