All other provisions of the Contract Documents remain unchanged.



- Q. Units show carpet flooring in certain rooms. KCHA does not like to use carpet flooring. Advise what flooring will be used in what rooms.
- A. Second floor bedrooms only. Ground level units do not receive any carpet.
- Q. SOW says tub shower faucet. Is this a new shower valve or new shower trim?
- A. New shower valve and trim.
- Q. Insurance docs (page 36) say 4 units need rewire. Does this mean re-wire the 4 units completely including new a panel and breakers?
- A. Only replacement of damaged existing wiring.
- Q. Insurance docs (page 36) say 4 units need rough-in plumbing. Does this mean 4 units need all plumbing pipes replaced?
- A. Only replacement of damaged existing plumbing.
- Q. Does that fascia need to be replaced on building A?
- A. I am assuming this is asking about fascia behind gutters at the roof level. Yes, please include complete fascia replacement in pricing.
- Q. Are we painting all walls and ceilings in all units we are working on?
- A. Yes, all walls and ceilings.
- Q. Are we painting all existing doors and trim in units?
- A. Yes, all existing doors and trim.
- Q. Plans show different amounts of new appliances then material list. Confirm new appliances amount and what units.
- A. Please utilize the Insurance docs for the more accurate list of re-used and replacement appliances and fixtures.
- Q. Residential carpenter wages went up to \$65.88 per hr in King County. Is this correct?
- A. Wage rates for this project are based on the bid opening date. L&I website say prevailing wage rates increased effective 8/31/25:
