Plan holders are hereby notified of the following changes and/or clarifications to the original Request for Proposals.

Section 3 Clarification – Youth Violence Prevention RFP

This Addendum is issued to clarify the applicability of Section 3 requirements for the Youth Violence Prevention RFP.

After further review and discussion of HUD regulations, KCHA has determined that Section 3 requirements do not apply to this type of procurement. While federal guidance encourages consideration of Section 3 businesses, Section 3 compliance is not required for this procurement.

Clarification of RFP Requirements and Scoring:

1. Section 3 requirements will not be applicable to this RFP.
2. Section 3 qualifications will not be evaluated or scored as part of proposal review.
3. The 15 point scoring criterion previously associated with Section 3 qualifications will not be used.
4. The maximum possible score for this RFP is 85 points.

1. Executive Summary	5
2. Organization Description and Experience	15
3. Partnerships and Collaboration	15
4. Program Description	20
5. Program Budget and Narrative Template.	15
6. Personnel and Management	15
Total Points Available	85

Post Award Administrative Requirement:

Following selection of contractor(s), KCHA will require completion of the Section 3 Business Certification form for the contract file only.

If a selected contractor identifies as a Section 3 Business, KCHA will engage in a separate post award discussion to determine whether any additional steps are appropriate.

All other provisions of the Request for Proposals shall remain unchanged.
